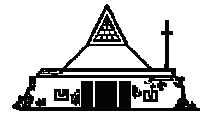
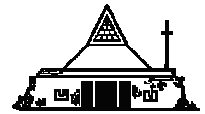

Level 4 “Learning as a Family” program

Children are required to attend all 3 activities and MUST be accompanied by a significant adult (Parent, godparent, grandparent, etc.)

These pastoral activities complement the “*Learning as a Family*” program.

If your child’s book is up to date, please feel free to bring it along and volunteer parents will review the book and take note of the progress.

If your child’s book is not up to date at the time of the event – just leave the book at home and we can have a look at it at a later date. The priority is that your child does not miss the event. Unfortunately, we cannot offer make-up events.
